

EFT early withdrawal Statement:

When you signed up for a year long EFT payment plan, your monthly dues were discounted 12.95 a month for making a year long commitment. You paid 47.00 and “month to month” members pay 59.95. If you want to be released from your EFT, you must make up the difference in the two payment plans.

Amount due before next EFT: 12.95 X the number of months used.

It is important to us to keep the integrity of our memberships. We have numerous people who pay the month to month rate without the discount because they don't want to make a year commitment. If we simply allow people to stop the EFT any time prior to the year, we are not being fair to our whole membership.

While we understand that circumstances occur, we feel it is in the best interest of fairness to all of our members not to cancel memberships except for the reasons stated on the membership agreement and mandated by the state of Connecticut.

All of our financed monthly memberships are outsourced to a billing company to which we pay a fee for processing your membership over the year.

Month to Month Memberships: paying for 30 days.

If you don't use your membership, you do not get a refund. You purchased time at this facility, it is your responsibility to use it. If you buy fresh food and don't use it before it goes bad/expires, you cannot return it to the store. Please understand we cannot make exceptions to this. We must maintain integrity with our members. If you have a doctor's note or a family emergency, we will extend your month for that time period. You must submit a doctor's note for medical reasons and a personal letter for family issues.

Week Free is for new members only. This does not include members who have taken time off.

Discounted Paid in Full memberships will be refunded for the reasons stated on your membership agreement at the pro rated rate of a month to month membership.

The above statements refer to Senior, Student, Family, Individual and Karate Parent/Student memberships. The only change would be in the rate applied to the refund.
